Your appeal must be submitted no later than 10 days prior to the beginning of the semester you are appealing to receive aid in.

Degree sought at UACCH:

Federal regulations require students to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in three areas – Completion Rate, Cumulative Grade Point Average, and they must achieve their degree within a certain number of hours or semesters (150% rule) – to be eligible for financial aid.

Students who have attempted more than 90 credit hours or have already obtained an Associate or Bachelor's degree are not considered to be making Satisfactory Academic Progress and will be placed on Financial Aid Exclusion. If you have a reason or extenuating circumstances as to why you have more then 90 attempted hours and want to continue your education, please follow the steps below to appeal your Financial Aid Exclusion.

Steps for appealing too many hours (150%)

- 1. Complete Financial Aid file.
2. Must have official transcripts from ALL previous college on file at Enrollment Service Department.
3. Attach an Official Degree Plan prepared by your academic advisor.
4. After receiving the degree audit, write a letter explaining your situation and which degree you are seeking and attach to this form.
5. Sign and attach this form to your written statements and documentation and return it to:
