**Please note that we do not offer Kids' College to upcoming Kindergarten students.

PROPOSALS

- Please submit a DETAILED class proposal for each age group, each week, and each class you wish to teach. Blank proposal forms are attached. Deadline is 3:30 pm on February 1, 2019.
- Each age/grade class must be specifically catered to that group. Title your class accordingly, if you want to teach the same class topic, title the class so that it will captivate that child's attention according to their age. I'm looking to add variety to the classes we offer, I strongly encourage you to focus on STEAM principals. If you would like to get together and talk more about the topics, please feel free to contact me.

- Each teacher may offer ONE class per age/grade span. Example: You MAY teach art week 1 and week 2 in the mornings. You may NOT teach art week 1 mornings and science week 2 mornings. You MAY teach art in the mornings and science in the afternoons, since the afternoons are a different age group.
- ***Class TOPICS are first-come, first-serve from proposals received. ***
- Computer labs are also first-come, first-serve.
- Clearly indicate on the proposal forms which weeks/grades you are submitting each proposal for.
- If you are in doubt about your availability to teach a certain week, DO NOT submit a proposal for that week.

Please be assured that your proposal will be looked over carefully and thoughtfully. Please note - proposals that offer detailed descriptions and educational value while still keeping it fun, will be ones that stand out. Submission of a proposal is not a job guarantee.
