



TIERS OF ACCEPTANCE

Collegiate Academy High School Admission Requirements

Conditionally admitted students must achieve ACT scores of 19 (or equivalent placement exam) in Reading and English by May 1 of their sophomore high school year in order to remain in the Collegiate High School.

TIER 1

Group A – Fully Qualified

ACT score of 19 in Reading, English, and Math (or)

Accuplacer scores of 78 in Reading, 83 in Sentence Skills, and 77 in Elementary Algebra

Group B – Qualified with Math Deficiency

ACT score of 19 in Reading and English (or)

Accuplacer scores of 78 in Reading and 83 in Sentence Skills

TIER 2

Conditionally Admitted

Requires recommendation from Principal & Counselor, review of academic records, and an interview.

ACT score of 19 in Reading and ACT score of 17 in English (or)

Accuplacer scores of 78 in Reading and 76 in Sentence Skills

Minimum ACT score of 15 in Math or Accuplacer score of 31 in Elementary Algebra or 31 in Arithmetic

TIER 3

Conditionally Admitted

Requires recommendation from Principal & Counselor, review of academic records, and an interview.

ACT score of 17 in Reading and English (or)

Accuplacer scores of 70 in Reading, 76 in Sentence Skills

Minimum ACT score of 15 in Math or Accuplacer score of 31 in Elementary Algebra or 31 in Arithmetic

TIER 4

Conditionally Admitted

Requires recommendation from Principal & Counselor, review of academic records, and an interview.

ACT score of 17 in Reading and ACT Score of 15 in English (or)

Accuplacer scores of 70 in Reading, 70 in Sentence Skills

Minimum ACT score of 15 in Math or Accuplacer score of 31 in Elementary Algebra or 31 in Arithmetic
